A thorough and realistic emergency plan is fundamental to your ability to mitigate incidents and minimize adverse effects on people, productivity and the environment. Managers use emergency plans to train employees and prepare the organization. Emergency responders use the plan during an incident to manage the situation and minimize the consequences. Following an incident, managers use the plan to restore operations and identify areas for improvement.
